#### Candidates for the study programme:

The basic condition for admission is the completion of the 2nd degree programme in the study programme of history teaching combined, history, general history or related disciplines and successful completion of the entrance examination, in which they demonstrate the depth and scope of knowledge necessary for doctoral studies with a focus on the chosen topic of the dissertation.

The candidate shall apply for one of the dissertation topics announced by the faculty and published on the faculty's website at least two months before the date of the admission procedure. This procedure enables the inclusion of future PhD students in the research activities of the Faculty.

The entrance examination consists of the following parts:

1. oral presentation of the submitted dissertation project and debate on it. In the debate to the project, they will demonstrate the prerequisites for scientific work, including a good orientation in foreign and domestic scientific production
  2. demonstration of knowledge of the required master's degree, the extent of and depth of literature studied and the prerequisites for the 3rd degree;
  3. a language examination in one non-Slavic language - the applicant shall demonstrate the ability to ability to communicate in at least one non-Slavic language (or demonstrate by a state examination in a foreign (world) language); the foreign language examination is in written form with focusing on the translation of a professional paper on the subject of the study the subject of the programme.
- Computer literacy is also a prerequisite (Word, Excel, Power Point,Internet).

Publication activity and other factors worthy of consideration are included in the final evaluation - work experience, connection to a national or international project, study stays abroad, placement at faculty and national competitions of the SVOUČ, the Rector's commendation and/or the Dean's commendation for the bachelor's thesis, diploma thesis, or outstanding results during studies, successful participation in competitions related to the relevant study programme, work in a civic association.

Candidates are admitted to a predetermined number of places by the Dean in a given form of study. The entrance examination is held before a committee - the composition of which is proposed by the union committee and approved by the dean of the faculty.

An accepted applicant becomes a student of doctoral studies on the day of enrolment, the date of which is determined by the dean.

### **Application of the graduate**

The graduate of the third degree of university studies of the didactics of history programme will be able to competently perform the activity of a university teacher of didactics of history or the work of a professional research and development worker in research and application departments and workplaces of state and public administration. In these, he/she will be able to accentuate the importance of social communication of historical knowledge used for educational purposes in contexts in which the past gives meaning to the present and implies the future.

**The study is completed with a successful defence of the dissertation.**
