### Candidates for the study programme:

Candidates for the study programme must have completed the 2nd cycle of higher education. They must successfully pass an entrance examination in which they demonstrate the depth and the necessary scope of knowledge required for doctoral studies with a focus on the chosen topic of the dissertation. Submit a written project on the chosen dissertation topic of 8-10 pages. In the discussion of this project, they will demonstrate the prerequisites for scientific work, including a good orientation in foreign and domestic scientific production.

Candidates apply for one of the topics announced by the faculty and published on the faculty's website at least two months before the date of the admission procedure. This

procedure allows for the inclusion of future PhD students in the research activities of the Faculty.

**The components of the admission procedure are:**

- 1) an oral examination in linguistic, didactic and literary disciplines close to the topic of the chosen dissertation,
- 2) a defence of the research project to be the subject of the dissertation,
- 3) proof of the candidate's computer literacy (Word, Excel, Power Point, Internet).

The entrance examination will be held before a committee whose composition is proposed by the departmental committee and approved by the Dean of the Faculty. Based on the results of the entrance examination, the Dean shall decide whether or not to accept the candidate within 30 days of the date of the entrance examination.

The admitted candidate becomes a doctoral student on the date of enrolment, the date of which is determined by the Dean.

**Application of the graduate**

The graduate will primarily find employment in the labour market as a university teacher (assistant professor), researcher, linguist or literary scholar.

Given the wide range of acquired knowledge, skills, competences and competences, he/she can also find employment in various other spheres for which the qualification guaranteed by obtaining the 3rd cycle of higher education is relevant. These areas are: provision and management of research and development infrastructure, acquisition, processing and dissemination of information in the field of science and technology, cooperation in the field of science and technology with universities, other legal entities and entrepreneurs carrying out research and development, work in public administration, in school management, in the media, in cultural and awareness-raising work, in leading and expert positions in the publishing and journalistic field, in international educational institutions, organisations and companies in an intercultural and interdisciplinary context.
